Celebrate the Coast Guard Birthday



On January 26, 2019, in Coronado, California, the Navy League's Coronado Council will host the Commissioning Ceremony and events surrounding it to commemorate the legacy of Navy Seal, Michael Monsoor, and welcome the ship that bears his name into the active fleet of the United States Navy.

USS Michael Monsoor (DDG-1001) is the second ship of the Zumwalt class of guided missile destroyers. Christened on June 18, 2016, the future USS Michael Monsoor will be one of the largest destroyers and most technologically advanced surface combatants in the world.
