
Hang onto your seat, we're headed into the Danger Zone!

Captain Dan Pederson, USN (Retired) First "Skipper" of Navy's TOP GUN Fighter School

On the 50th anniversary of the creation of the "Topgun" Navy Fighter School in 1969, its founder, Captain Dan Pederson, shares the remarkable inside story of how he and eight other risk-takers revolutionized the art of aerial combat.

When American fighter jets were being downed at an unprecedented rate during the Vietnam War, the United States Navy turned to a then young lieutenant commander, Dan Pedersen, to figure out a way to reverse their dark fortune. On a shoestring budget and



with little support, Pedersen picked eight of the finest pilots to help train a new generation to bend jets like the F-4 Phantom to their will and learn how to dogfight all over again.

What resulted was nothing short of a revolution -- one that took young American pilots from the crucible of combat training in the California desert to the blistering skies of Vietnam, in the process raising America's Navy combat kill ratio from two enemy planes downed for every American plane lost to more than 22 to 1.

TOPGUN emerged not only as an icon of America's military dominance immortalized by Hollywood but as a vital institution that would shape the nation's military strategy for generations to come.

In his new book, <u>TOPGUN, An American Story</u> Captain Pederson takes his readers on a colorful and thrilling ride -- from Miramar to Area 51 to the decks of aircraft carriers in war and peace-through a historic moment in air warfare. He helped establish a legacy that was built by him and his "Original Eight" -- the best of the best -- and carried on for six decades by some of America's greatest leaders. *TopGun* is a heartfelt and personal testimony to patriotism, sacrifice, and American innovation and daring.



As a Naval Aviator, and combat veteran, Captain Pederson accumulated 6100 flight hours in 31 aircraft types and survived 1014 arrested carrier landings. He served as the Commanding Officer of the aircraft carrier USS RANGER CV-61, the super tanker USS Wichita AOR-1, Carrier Air Wing 15 deployed aboard the USS Coral Sea CV-43, Fighter Squadron 143 onboard the USS Enterprise CVN-65. and also served as the Deputy Commander for Operations in the US Pacific Fleet. Captain Pederson has extensive experience in flight testing, aircraft maintenance, logistics and aircraft performance analysis.

Captain Pederson is also the co-author of the book "Scream of Eagles" with author, Robert Wilcox, which recounts the formation of TOP GUN. Captain Pederson will have the *TOPGUN* book available for purchase at the dinner.

Congressional Fly-In Update

On Thursday, November 14th, the Imperial Valley Council on behalf of the Pacific Southwest Region participated in Navy League's 4th Biennial 2019 Anchors Aweigh Congressional Fly-in on Capitol Hill. Representing the Region was Council President Ted Gallinat, National Vice President Lisa Gallinat, and Sally Nockold, Newport Beach Council.

A total of 88 Navy Leaguers from around the country met with a total of 250 Congressional meetings. The Region representatives held six meetings with Rep. Juan Vargas (D-51), Rep. Scott Peters (CA-52), Rep. Susan Davis (CA-53), Rep. Nannette Barragan (CA-44), Rep. Ken Calvert (CA-42), and Rep. Tom O'Halloran (AZ-01). The meetings were held to amplify the Navy League's support of important legislation to prepare our sea services for the future.

Congressional meeting focus was concentrated on the following Navy League initiatives:

- Support budget stability and avoid continuing resolutions.
- Fund Navy readiness recovery, and shipbuilding, to reach the right mix of ships in the fleet and other priorities.
- Recapitalize aging Marine Corps aircraft.
- Raise the Coast Guard's Acquisition, Construction, and Improvements budget to \$2B/year, and fund operations at 5% per year growth.
- Enforce and protect cargo preference laws, the Jones Act, the Maritime Security program, and training ships.
- Invest in readiness and training for all sea services.

The Navy League uses a grass-roots legislative approach to advocate on behalf of the sea services both in our communities and on Capitol Hill. We strongly need the voices or our members and community to make a difference.
